

2009 Annual Meeting Announcement

In accordance with National Credit Union Administration (NCUA)-approved bylaws, the North Carolina Community Federal Credit Union's Chairman of the Board, Edward E. Farris, has announced that the 2009 Annual Meeting is scheduled to take place on Thursday, April 23, 2009 in the Main Lobby of 2401 East Ash Street, Goldsboro. The business meeting will begin at 7:00 p.m. The 2009 Nominating Committee, pursuant to the above-noted bylaws, has nominated the following candidates for the three open seats on the Board for three year terms:

Raymond Burrell has been a member of the credit union since 1985 and was elected to the Board in 1996. In 1997, he retired from the U.S. Air Force after 24 years of service. He is employed by Wayne Community College where he is the Division Head, Business and Computer Technologies/Agricultural and Natural Resources Division. His education includes a bachelor's degree from North Carolina Agriculture and Technical State University, Greensboro, North Carolina, an M.B.A from the University of Guam, Agana, Guam, and graduate studies in Economics from East Carolina University, and Central Michigan University.

Faye Porter has been a member of the credit union since 2007 and was appointed to the Board in 2008. She graduated from Meredith College in 1978 with a bachelor's degree in Business Administration. She has been involved in the insurance and real estate industry for over 22 years.

Leslie C. Nelson, a former Supervisory Committee Member, is currently serving on the Board of Directors. Nelson is a retired Air Force Major, and a former Vice President of East Coast Federal Savings Bank.

Nominations for vacancies may also be submitted to the Nominating Committee by NCCFCU members eligible to vote in credit union elections through a petition signed by a minimum of 500 NCCFCU members eligible to vote in credit union elections.

Each petitioner must submit a statement of qualifications and biographical data with the petition. Petitions must be submitted to the Secretary of the Board of Directors, 2401 East Ash Street, Goldsboro, NC 27534 no later than 11:59 PM, March 9, 2009. All nominees must submit a signed certificate stating that they are agreeable to nomination and will serve if elected to office.
